SUMMARY OF THE APPLICATIONS:

File B-02-19: A Consent to Sever application has been submitted by Miller & Urso Surveying Inc. on behalf of Ski Ridge Estates Inc. requesting to sever 0.4ha from their holdings on Janey Avenue for the purpose of a lot addition to be added to North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority lands for the purpose of facilitating trail connections.

File B-03-19: A Consent to Sever application has been submitted by Miller & Urso Surveying Inc. on behalf of the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority requesting to sever 2.1 Ha from their holdings in the area of the Laurentian Ski Hill for the purpose of a lot addition to be added to adjacent vacant lands as part of a land exchange between Ski Ridge Estates and the Conservation Authority to facilitate trail connection.

The Chairman called the Hearing to Order at 9:30 a.m. and outlined the procedure to be followed and read the Notice of Hearing. A Planning Report was prepared and distributed prior to the Hearing. The Report referenced the Zoning By-law, the Official Plan, the Provincial Policy Statements and the Growth Plan for Northern Ontario and concluded the application was good planning. Comments received offered no objections.

Mr. Miller was invited to discuss the application on behalf of his clients. Mr. Miller advised the TransCanada Pipeline and Hydro One right-of-way are both located in the immediate vicinity of the property however, the parcels do not have road frontage.

The proposal is for a land swap. The transfer is to connect the main trail with other trails within the escarpment. Discussion ensued with respect to monetary exchange due to size difference and whether the lands to add to Ski Ridge Estates will form part of a Subdivision. Mr. Miller clarified that at this time Ski Ridge Estates had no plans with the property acquisition.
